

WINSLOW BELLS – PEALS 1956 & 2006

On 1st December 1955 a coach party from Winslow with friends from the surrounding area witnessed the casting of two new treble bells for St Laurence by J. Taylor at the Loughborough bell foundry. The ring of 6 was thus increased to 8

1956 Following the installation and dedication in 1956 the first peal on the full 8 was rung on Saturday May 5, 1956, in 3 hrs and 6 mins a peal of 5040 Plain Bob Major, Tenor 19 ¼ cwt. Composed by J. Carter Conducted by Walter Lee
